So we're hoping you'll consider making Noah's Landing part of your classroom this fall. Let our animals bring your science lessons to life.

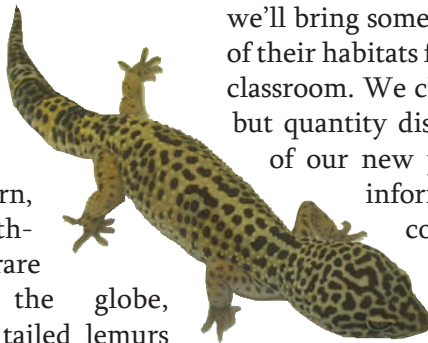
